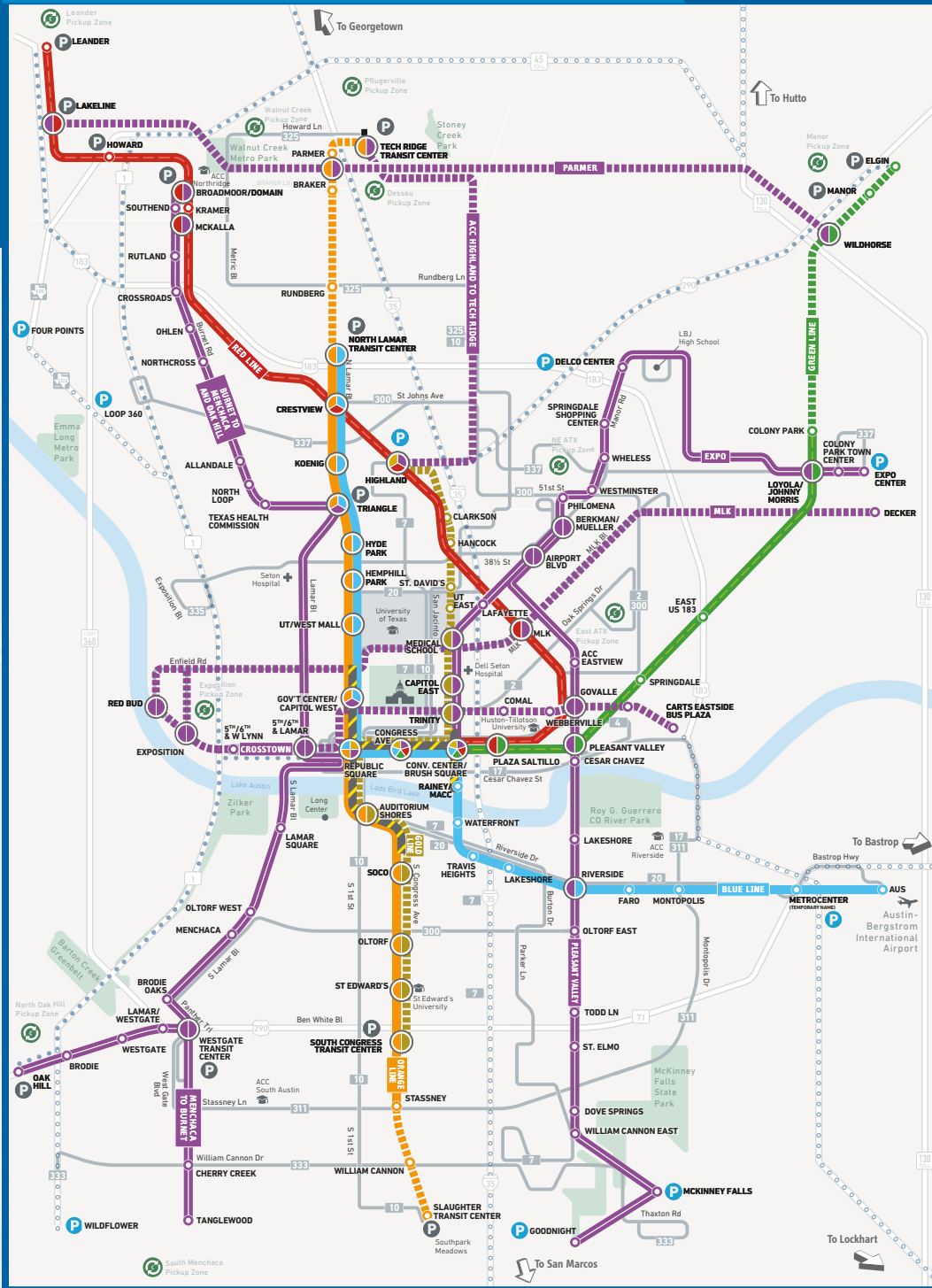

As of Aug 2021 — Map represents 15% design of program.

**Project Connect** is a program of transit projects that will increase connectivity to more neighborhoods and transform the Austin region into one of the most equitable, sustainable, and innovative areas of the country.



**Four new MetroRapid routes** and a 100% zero-emission fleet



**Two Light Rail lines** designed with strong connections to CapMetro's bus network, improving access for all to the city's busiest corridors. Plus, investments in Regional Rail lines with new stations and improvements for increased service frequency and reliability.



**Transit Tunnel** under downtown will separate light rail from the street, enhancing safety and on-time performance.



**New Park & Rides** and transit center facilities.



**New neighborhood circulators** to offer additional connections into the transit system.
