
Austin Transit Partnership

Austin Transit Partnership is the local government corporation responsible for implementing Project Connect and leading Austin Light Rail Phase 1

Role of the ATP Board: The ATP Board of Directors provides board leadership for the independent entity, with a Board appointed executive director to lead the day-to-day operations of the organization.



ATP Board of Directors Composition





ATP Community Expert Director Qualifications: Per the ATP Articles of Incorporation

Area of Expertise	Criteria for Community Expert Directors
Finance	 At least 10 years of experience in finance, financial management, banking or investing with a focus on large capital projects; and Experience with budget over \$250M and/or comparable academic financial policy experience
Engineering & Construction	 At least 10 years of experience in engineering or construction of large capital projects in any sector (transit, energy, industrial, commercial); and Experience with multiple projects over \$100M (price/value/cost) or \$250M cumulative
Community Planning or Sustainability	 At least 10 years of experience in urban planning, community planning, equitable Transit Oriented Development (eTOD), sustainability, and/or environmental planning; and Experience with community engagement with preferably three (3) to five (5) years of specific experience



ATP Board Member Nomination & Appointment Process

- Board of Directors appointment process defined in ATP Articles of Incorporation
- Community Expert Directors nomination and appointment process led by City Council and CapMetro Board
 - Nominating Committee
- ATP Board Member terms expire on Dec. 31, 2024
- City Council and CapMetro Board separately appoint a representative to serve a 2-yr term
- Community Expert Directors will have staggered terms (2-4 yrs)











ATP Board Member Appointments – Community Expert Directors

Austin City Council Resolution No. 20221208-074 & CapMetro Board Resolution No. AI-2022-683 provides direction to the Nominating Committee process:

- Nominating Committee process and criteria for selection made publicly available at the time the Nominating Committee publishes a solicitation for applications.
- Nominating Committee is to seek feedback from the CAC on the criteria for selection before the criteria is finalized.
- Applications are made publicly available once submitted to ATP.
- Preliminary selection, including interviews or elimination of applications by the Nominating Committee, made public as soon as the Nominating Committee decides.
- Nominations will be made public for at least two weeks in advance of approval by Council and CapMetro Board.
- Nominating Committee may recommend more than one nominee to Council and CapMetro Board for further deliberation and appointment.











ATP Board Member Appointments

Date*	Summary of Actions
August 8	Informational presentation to the Community Advisory Committee. Feedback on selection criteria, to supplement required qualifications, will be provided to Nominating Committee.
August 12 – September 13	ATP initiates 30-day application process related to three Community Expert Directors, after which ATP staff will verify qualifications and forward the applications to the Nominating Committee. Results will be published online.
October	Nominating Committee process to determine recommendations related to Community Expert Directors.
November/December	Actions by City Council and CapMetro Board to appoint Community Expert Directors. City Council and CapMetro must also each appoint a representative to the ATP Board.
January 2025	New terms for the 5-member ATP Board begin.
