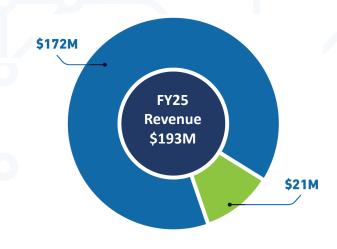

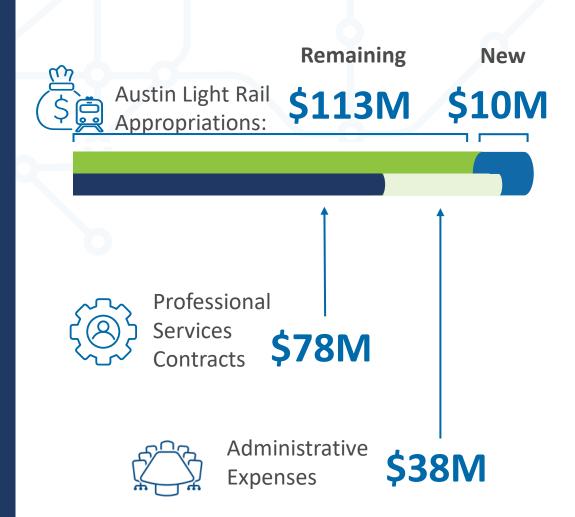

FY25 Appropriations
